Report : 2019 -20

Due to the Covid Pandemic no much active initiatives could be carried out during this period but the Alumni Association was engaged with its regular activities. During the Period the 4th Phanidhar Majumdar Memorial Award for Borgeet was awarded to Prastuti Dutta with a Certificate and Cash Award of Rs.2000. During this period a New Committee was constituted on February 15, 2020. A executive committee meeting was conducted on 29/02/2020 to plan the activities of the year ,2020. On 12th March ,2020, the Alumni Association organised a Lecture programme on Sexual Harrasment of Women at Workplace ,PPR, 2013. Dr. Purnima Dowerah Saikia ,Principal ,DHSK Law College ,Dibrugarh acted as the Resource Person in the programme. An Executive Committee Meeting was held on 16/08/2020 in online mode through Google Meet Platform. The meeting was convened to discuss about the future course of action of the Association.

Report: 2020-21

A National Level Webinar on ‘Gender.Society and Politics’ in association with the IQAC ,MDK Girls’ College on 21/08/2020 amongst the Covid times via online platform. Dr.Alpana Borgohain ,Professor and Former Head ,Department of Women’s Studies ,Gauhati University acted as a resource person.In the webinar,Dr.Borgohain elaborately discussed about the relationship between Gender ,Society and Politics and opined that women are equipped with all qualities to emerge as important social agents but the issue of ‘Gender’ comes as a barrier in different fronts and prevents Women’s Growth and elevation.The Webinar was a successful one ensuring the active participation of 65 participants.A mental health awareness programme on ‘Therapeutic Practices for Mental and Physical Wellness’ was organised on 13th March ,2021.The resource person for the same was Dr.Bornali Nath Dowerah.The programme was a great success with the active participation of 29 members.The Best Athlete Award ,2021 was presented to Riji Bora for the year .The Phanidhar Majumder Memorial award for Borgeet was awarded to Chinmoyee K.Borthakur with a cash award of Rs. 2000 and a Certificate.

Report: 2021-22

One of the foundational achievements during this period was the formal registration of the MDKG College Alumni Association as a legal entity. This milestone not only provided our association with a structured framework for operations but also enhanced our credibility and ability to engage more effectively with alumni and external stakeholders. The Association formally got registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1980 on 25/05/2022.



The Alumni Association ,MDK Girls’ College organised a meeting of the Executive Committee on 31/05/2022 through online mode.The objective of the meeting was to decide about the issues related with the forthcoming General Meeting of the Association. Following that a meeting of the Alumni College Committee Unit held on 12 /06/2022 to discuss the about organising a General Meeting of the Association.Accordingly the 12th General Meeting of the Association was held on 18/06/2022.The basic objective of the meeting was to constitute a new Committe for the Alumni Association dissolving the old one.Following the decisions of the meeting, a new committee was formed .Decision was also taken to raise the funds of Alumni Association.Amonst the many decisions adopted,a decision was also taken to create a facebook link was also created for the contribution of funds of the association.Best Athelete award 2022 was awarded to Tina Gogoi on 18/06/2022. The 7th Phanidhar Majumder Memorial award for Borgeet was awarded to Juktarani Deka with a cash award of Rs. 2500 and a Certificate.The Association recieved a donation of Wireless Head Phone Set (Sony) from Dr.Anita Baruwa during the period.

Report: 2022-23

MDKG College Alumni Association’s Executive Committee Meeting was held on 11/06/2022 to discuss about the activities to be adopted during the upcoming Diamond Jubilee ,2023. It was decided to undertake many activities during the timeline of celebrating of the Diamond Jubilee. To mark the ongoing celebrations of Diamond Jubilee an ‘Exhibition Cum Sale’ with the target of ‘Touching the Grassroots’ was organized by the Alumni Association of the college to support and bring to light the budding entrepreneurs who comprised of present students, alumni and a few non – alumni women entrepreneurs. The date of program was 22/09/22.



The Exhibition showcased talents and creativity of various participants in food and bakery, garments, handicrafts, garments, home decors, paintings, nurse – plants etc. The Deputy Commissioner inaugurated the program in the presence of the principal, teachers, students and participants. In all 50 participants exhibited their items and a very good response was received. A highlight of our activities was the organization of an exhibition showcasing the talents and achievements of our alumni. This event not only celebrated the diverse accomplishments of our graduates but also provided a platform for networking and collaboration among alumni and students. The exhibition featured artwork, innovations, entrepreneurial ventures, and academic achievements, highlighting the breadth of talent nurtured at MDKG College. Throughout the years, the Alumni Association organized several awareness and health camps aimed at promoting well-being among alumni and the broader community. These camps covered diverse topics such as mental health awareness, preventive health screenings, and healthy lifestyle practices. By partnering with healthcare professionals and leveraging the expertise of alumni in the healthcare sector, we successfully reached a significant number of participants, contributing to their overall well-being. On 05/11/2022, a Community Awareness Programme and Blood donation Camp was organised by the Alumni Association in collaboration with the PTA. The Alumni Association Conducted Blood Donation Science Awareness Program on 5/11/2022 at Nagakhelia Gaon, Dibrugarh in association with Dibrugarh Blood Donors' Forum.





The objective of this program was to create awareness among womenfolk of the village regarding their hemoglobin level, need of having nutritious food, why and how to be cautious about hemoglobin levels and also the importance of knowing one's blood group.

The resource person was Mr. Ashu Paul and he delivered an important speech on consciousness among women regarding knowing about blood group, to have food rich in antioxidants and minerals and what diseases can occur in the presence of low hemoglobin. After this, 43 beneficiaries availed the facilities of the program. The program was provided with technical assistance from the Department of Health and Family Welfare and the Barbaruah Health Centre took the lead. A total of 5 trained staffs of the department consisting of a nurse, ANMs, Asha workers were present along with the Program Officer, Mr. Biplob Borgohain. The program started from 1pm and ended at 4pm.

A contribution of Rs.20000 was made by the Alumni Association as a token of goodwill gesture to its Alma mater to organise the All Assam Half Marathon as a part of Diamond Jubilee celebration on 27/01/2023.



Consequent upon this, an executive meeting was held on 04/02/2023 to discuss about the future agenda of the association. Again on 08/04/2023 and 29/04/2023 executive committee meetings were held to discuss the diverse matters concerning the association. On 27/05/2023, a talk cum awareness programme on the topic 'Early Marriage and its Impact' was organised by the alumni association in 'Nagakhelia', the adopted village of the institution.



Report: 2023-24

On 14/06/2023, 'A Talk cum Awareness Programme' was organised by the association in Dikom High School and Dikom PD ME School, on the Topic 'Early Marriage and its impact on Adolocents'. The Resource person for the programme was Dr. Nabanita Nirmolia, Associate Professor, Department of Community Mediciane, Assam Medical College, Dibrugarh.



A counseling session was conducted by the Alumni Association for the students of B.A and B.SC 1st year students of the institution. One of the Alumnae of the institute Ms. Nasifa Khatoon, Multi skill counsellor working under AMC acted as the resource person in the Programme. The Programme was a huge success ensuring the participation of 57 students.



The Final Executive Meeting for organising the Alumni Meet was held on 24/08/2023. A water Purifier of Eureka Forbes costing Rs 11000 was donated by Manashi Baruah, an alumnae of the institute. The water purifier was fixed at the Teacher's Common Room. She also contributed Rs.2000 for repairing the old water filter.

The Alumni Association organised a grand Alumni Meet marking the celebration of Diamond Jubilee. The alumni meet of MDKG College, Dibrugarh, held on 3rd September 2023, was a resounding success, rekindling memories and forging new connections among alumni spanning several decades. 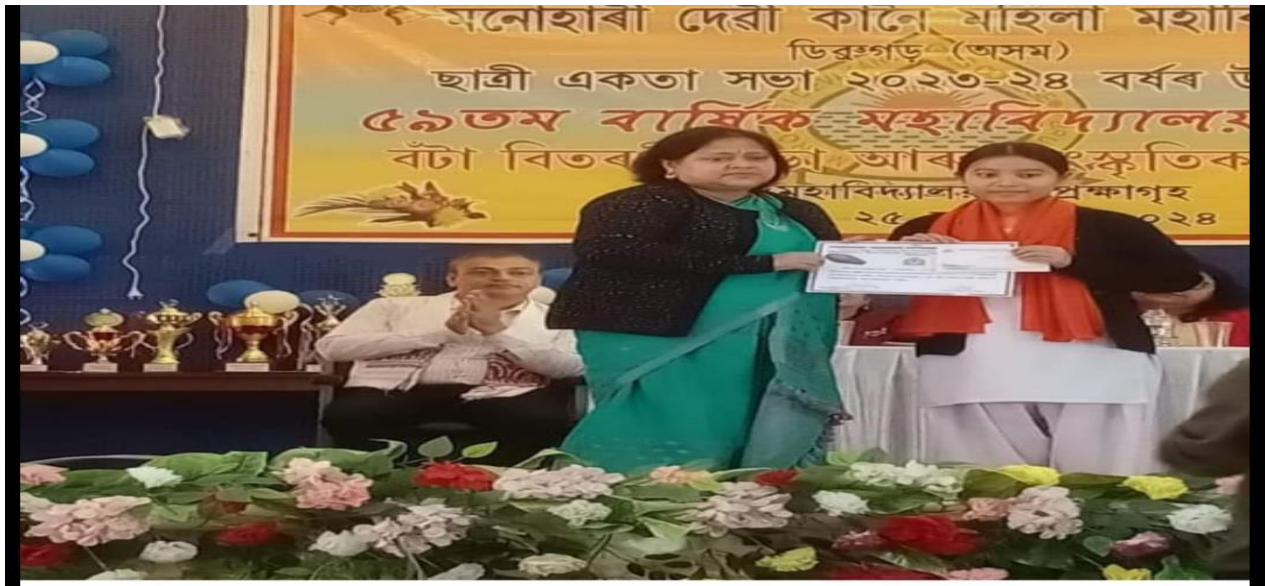
