Moreover, the programme was highly appreciable with the Village women interactions through sharing various experiences of life on the occasion of Women's day.

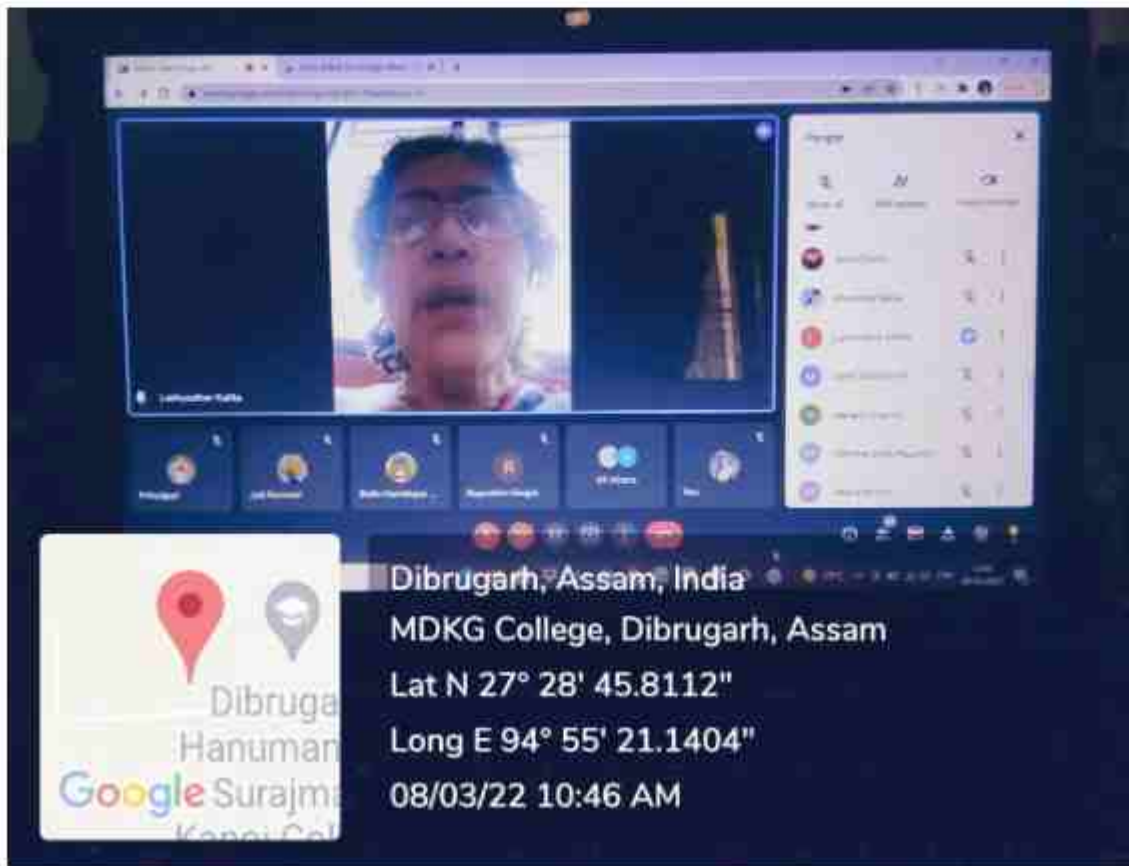

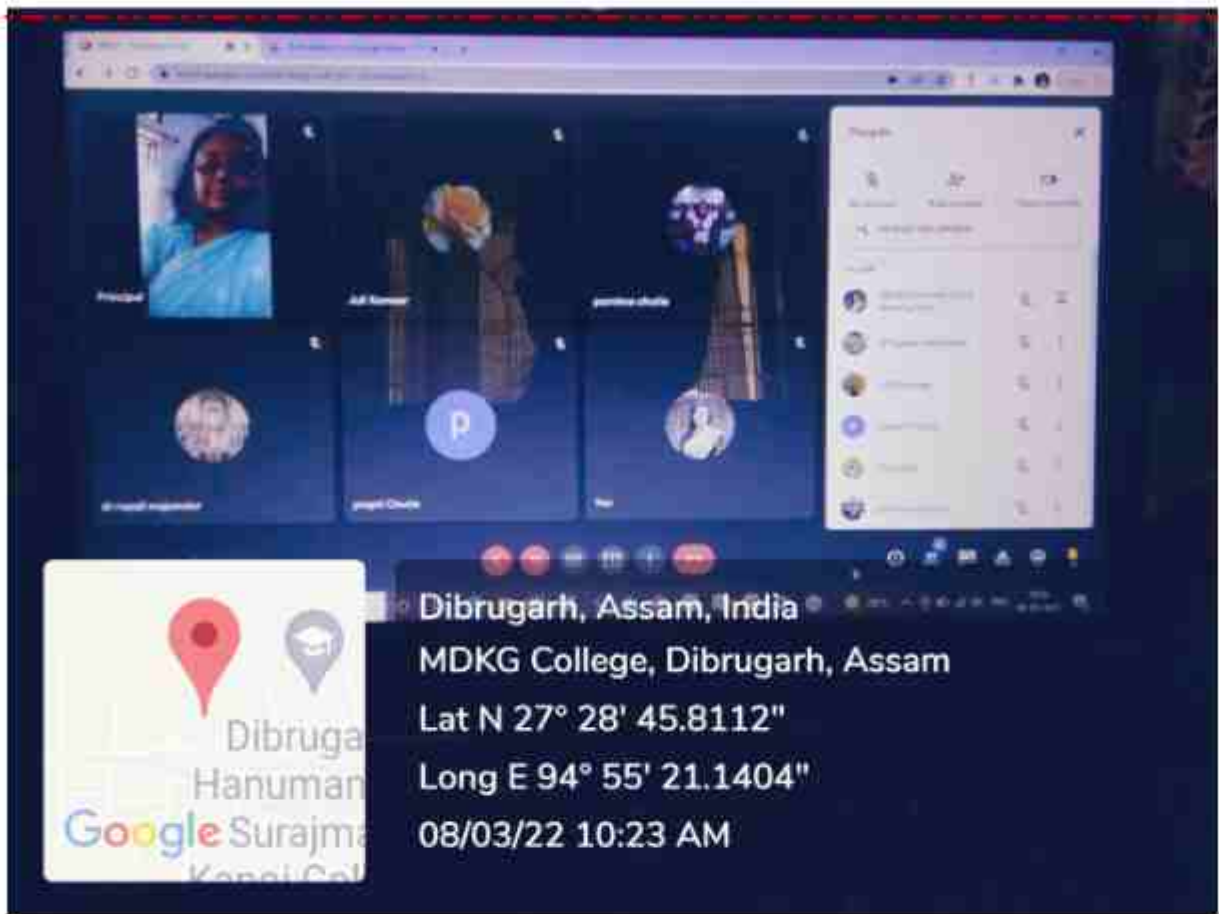

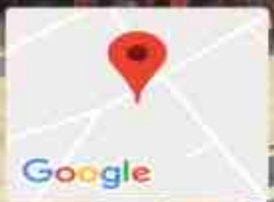
