- 1. APDCL power grid: The power grid of Assam Power Distribution Company Ltd. (APDCL) is the primary source of electricity for the college
- 2. Diesel generators: The College has diesel generators (DG sets) installed in both campuses for emergency backup during grid failure.
- 3. Photovoltaic (solar) energy: The College currently has two solar street lights donated by Sri Jyoti Pd. Kanoi, Hon'ble member of the Governing Body of the college.

 Apart from this the installation of a rooftop solar project is currently under consideration.







Manohari Devi Kanoi Girls College Policy on Special Provisions for Students with Disabilities (Divyangjan)

Introduction

Manohari Devi Kanoi Girls College is committed to fostering an inclusive academic environment that supports the needs of all students, including those with disabilities. This policy outlines the college's commitment to providing equitable opportunities and reasonable accommodations to ensure that students with disabilities have equal access to educational programs and activities.

Scope

This policy applies to all students with disabilities enrolled at Manohari Devi Kanoi Girls College. It covers academic accommodations, physical accessibility, and support services necessary for students to fully participate in college life.

Definitions

Disability: A physical or mental impairment that substantially limits one or more major life activities.

Reasonable Accommodation: Modifications or adjustments to a course, program, service, activity, or facility that enable a student with a disability to participate fully and equally.

Specially Abled Person: Individuals with disabilities who require specific support or accommodations to access educational opportunities.

Objectives

To ensure that students with disabilities have equal access to educational programs and activities.

To provide necessary accommodations to support academic success and participation.

To raise awareness about disability issues and promote a culture of inclusivity.

Responsibilities

College Administration: To develop and implement policies that ensures accessibility and support for students with disabilities.

Faculty Members: To work with the Disability Services Office to implement reasonable accommodations and provide an inclusive learning environment.

Students: To communicate their needs and provide relevant documentation to the Disability Services Office in a timely manner.

Procedures for Requesting Accommodations

- Documentation: Students must provide documentation of their disability from a qualified professional. This
 documentation should detail the nature of the disability and the need for specific accommodations.
- Application: Students should submit a formal request for accommodations to the Disability Services Office.
 This request should include the necessary documentation and a description of the accommodations being requested.
- Implementation: Once approved, accommodations will be communicated to relevant faculty and implemented. The Disability Services Office will monitor and review the effectiveness of accommodations.
- Appeals: Students who feel their needs are not being met may appeal the decision through the college's grievance procedure.

Alternate sources of energy and energy conservation measures: Manohari Devi Kanoi Girls' College has installed two sets of Solar Panels in the Arts Campus. These Solar Energy Panels are donated by Jyotiprasad Kanoi. In the coming years, the institutions aim to install more solar energy panels to replace the conventional energy resources. The institution is yet to introduce Biogas plant, wheeling to the Grid and Sensor –based energy conservation system. Over the years the ,the college management has adopted a conscious decision to use LED bulbs /Power efficient equipment in the campus and thus all old non-led equipments are replaced to energy efficient electric gadgets. Moreover, stickers are pasted in many places of the college instructing for wise use of electricity and other equipments.






