1. Background

MDKG College is a public funded educational institution. As a public enterprise it has certain responsibilities towards its stakeholders that includes student community in particular and civil society in general. This institute, which renders education at UG level to the Arts faculty to a single gender student community since its inception; i.e. 1963, adds another dimension by starting the science faculty at UG level in the year 2016. Going one step ahead of its journey, the college started PG in Assamese from the year 2022 apart from running the existing Add On Courses in different departments. This premier institute for girls' education is well equipped with experienced and student centric teachers fraternity, physical facilities, ICT facilities, labs, library and many more facilities. The academic performances of students always add extra layer of pride and glory to its name. The fame of the college is further extended with the active participations of the teachers and students in different kinds of co curricular, extracurricular activities and other community based outreach programmes. Uncounted numbers of its alumni's who are serving the civil society in diverse fields with different positions are, in a true sense, the torch bearers of the upcoming students of the college.

2. Proposal

In the light of this background, the college has intended to propose a Monthly Talk Programme (MTP) series. The journey of the MTP will begin from the month of January, 2025.

3. Objectives

The core objective of the programme shall be to motivate the students in respect of achieving different desired goals in their lives and to give them an exemplary guidance to explore their potentials and to proceed towards their aims in lives.

It shall be expected that success story of their peers and different people around them will encourage and inspire them in life to go ahead and to achieve success.

4. Functionality

- > The Principal will appoint two persons as Joint Coordinators (JC) for this programme.
- The duration of the Joint Coordinators is three years or for a period that deems fit by the authority or earlier notification. However there is no bar and obligation for rescale selection.

- > The Joint Coordinators will finalise the guest / invited speakers in consultation with the principal.
- > The talk may be arranged on any day of a month subject to the convenience of the speaker and the students.
- > As far as possible, the Joint Coordinators will try to keep record of the speech or the speaker may be requested to give a written format of his speech.
- > Utmost care and consideration may be solicited for the overall development of the college while selecting speaker.
- > Priority will be given to invite alumnus as a speaker as far as possible and viable.

5. Financial Liabilities

- ❖ An upper cap of ceiling of Rupees Five Thousand (Rs. 5000/-) is proposed for a programme in a month for the first year. However exceptionally may be happened in some cases.
- Any member from the civil society (except a person having political affiliation) may donate any amount (either in cash or kind) for this programme either in a voluntary basis or in the memory/respect of any near and dear people.
- Any member from MDKG College may donate any amount (either in cash or kind) for this programme either as individual initiative or in the memory/respect of any near and dear people.
- ❖ The institute will duly acknowledge the assistance received for this purpose with gratitude soul.
